- Early learning resource center idea...Put all pre-school and kinder classes and teachers on one site to deal with huge disparity in needs (i.e. behavior remediation, social skills, and kids that come ready to tackle academics). Community use could be parenting classes. Evening classes could be enrichment and parenting classes. Kids are coming to our school less ready all the time.
