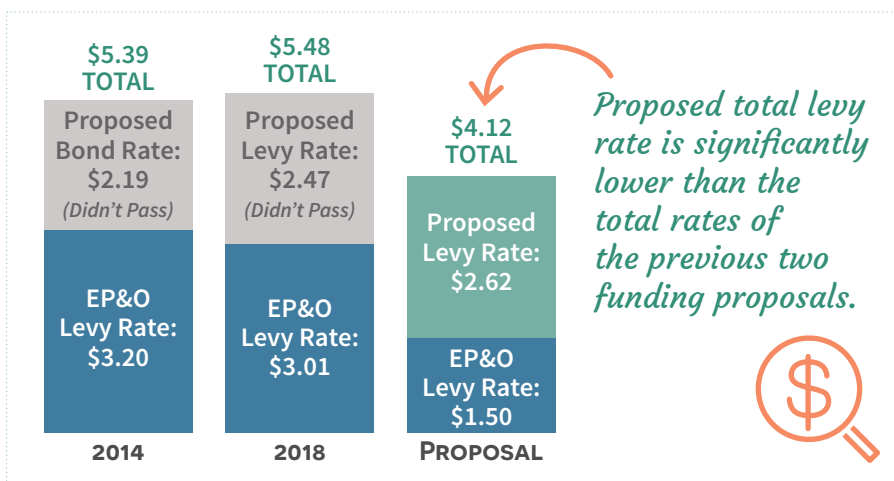
On **February 11, 2020**, the Port Angeles community will vote on a capital levy measure to fund much needed updates to our school facilities.

These are the top three facts you need to know about the measure:



WE LISTENED: LOWER TAX RATES.

The proposed levy has a combined local levy rate that is lower than past proposals (see chart). A 30-year, performance-based plan will keep rates consistent, while making needed improvements to strengthen our schools.



Good news!

We expect to receive approximately **\$18.4 MILLION IN STATE ASSISTANCE** should the levy pass!



WE WILL IMPROVE SAFETY & SECURITY.

Safety and security improvements, including secure entrances, will be implemented across the district. This is essential to keeping students and staff safe.



WE WILL START WITH STEVENS MIDDLE SCHOOL.

The Capital Levy will fund an expansion and remodel of Stevens Middle School, which has the most urgent needs. By starting with Stevens, we can reestablish the standard 6th-8th grade middle school system. After Stevens, the 30-year plan addresses facility needs at Franklin, Port Angeles High School, Hamilton, and Roosevelt.
