


SO YOU WANT TO BE A SCHOOL BUS DRIVER?

What does it take?

School bus driving is a perfect part-time job that offers a flexible schedule for a retired person or a stay at home parent looking for a little extra income with a great hourly rate.

Do you enjoy interactions with kids?
Do you have good driving skills and a good driving record?
Do you have a positive attitude and great people skills?
If you answered YES to these questions, then school bus driving could be a good fit for you!

The job of school bus driving is often very rewarding. Be an active participant in the safety of students.

Suggested schedule to follow to obtain your credentials to become a school bus driver:

- 1. Fill out application completely and provide reference letters; also include a current driving abstract obtained through the Department of Licensing (DOL).
- 2. While at DOL, get a current Commercial Driver's License (CDL) book. Study Chapters` 1, 2 and 3.
- 3. The district will screen your application.
- 4. If you get an interview, your references will be checked. If you are invited to attend class, have your fingerprints checked through Educational Service District (ESD).
- 5. Get CDL Physical from a Licensed, Certified Medical Examiner.
- 6. After you obtain your physical and you have studied CDL Book sections 1, 2 and 3, get your learners permit from DOL.
- 7. Obtain a current First Aid card.
- 8. Attend all classroom sessions and driving times as they are assigned.
- 9. Keep studying and then pass CDL Book Section 4 (Passenger), 5 (Air Brakes) and 10 (School Bus) at DOL.
- 10. Study Section 11 (Pre-Trip Inspection), Section 12 (Basic Controls-Backing) and Section 13 (The Road Test).
- 11. After you have completed and passed classroom and driving schedule and you have passed all your written tests at the DOL, the Driver Trainer will schedule an appointment for a driving test with a 3rd party tester. When you pass, go back to DOL and have your permit changed to Class B, P1S with Air Brake restrictions removed.
- 12. Port Angeles School District reserves the right to terminate training at any time.
